Day of Event

What happens if it rains?

The Derby Dash will go on rain or shine. Remember, wear layers.

Are strollers permitted?

Yes! Collapsible strollers are welcome. While on the course, please be courteous to the other walkers/runners.

Are dogs allowed on the course or at the park?

Designated service animals will be permitted.

Where is the Derby Dash?

The event is held at Whitnall Park, Franklin (plug in 8831 North Root River Parkway to GPS). The shelter/picnic area is labeled "Whitnall Park Beer Garden." Please refer to map at www.kidneywi.org/derby-dash

• Where can I park?

Angle parking is available on North Root River Parkway, East of 92nd (between Grange and Rawson). Overflow parking is also available west of 92nd on Whitnall Park Drive. Handicap parking will be available in the Picnic Area 1 parking lot. There is NO PARKING on 92nd or College. Download map at www.kidneywi.org/derby-dash

• Where is registration?

Registration is near the Start Line on Root River Parkway beginning at 8:00 AM. Registered runners and walkers will receive a race bib, t-shirt, and beer garden pint glass.

• Where can I find a bathroom?

There are indoor bathrooms at the Milwaukee County Parks Shelter (handicapped accessible) and portable restrooms mid-way on the course.

What if I need medical attention?

Bell Ambulance personnel will provide first aid (Start/Finish line).

• I have donations to turn in. Where should I drop them off?

Bring contributions to Registration. Checks should be made out to the *National Kidney Foundation of Wisconsin*. Use the 2019 Contribution Form (on NKFW website) for all cash, check or credit card donations.

• Are there awards?

Awards will be given to the top 5K male/female participant. There will be several special awards including top fundraiser, largest team and best Derby costume.

What food and beverages will be available?

Complimentary water and snacks will be available at the Finish Line. At the Shelter, *The Gift of Wings Grill* will offer a variety of food and snacks for purchase (cash & credit cards accepted) https://www.whitnallbeergarden.com/

What does the Whitnall Beer Garden offer?

The Whitnall Park Beer Garden opens at 9:30AM and offers a variety of beer from local and regional breweries. Hard sodas, cider, wine and non-alcoholic beverages are also available (cash and credit cards accepted).
